| 03 | Q: What type of French wine is typically made from Pinot Noir grapes?
A: Burgundy, specifically red Burgundy. | 15 | Q: How many pounds of grape are needed to make a bottle of wine?
A: 2.5 pounds |
| 04 | Q: What does a vertical wine tasting entail?
A: It means tasting wines from the same vineyard or winemaker from different years. | 16 | Q: What is the name for a wine made primarily or exclusively from one variety of grapes?
A: Varietal |

A: Red, white, pink (or rose), orange, and blue. | 17 | Q: What is the world's most popular varietal?
A: Chardonnay |
