Tasting Notes







Strawberries

Cherries

Enticing aromas of ripe plum, bouquet of violets and cocoa powder. Generous flavors of dark cherry and strawberries play the lead role mid palate with earthy floral notes and a touch of cedar spice. Bright acidity gives way to a lingering silky finish.

Winemaking Notes

Grapes from sites throughout the Central Coast and the North Coast were harvested at optimal maturity, then de-stemmed and gently placed into open-top stainless steel fermenters and cold soaked for three days prior to initiating fermentation. During fermentation, each tank is punched down two to three times daily. The fermented wine then was racked to oak for aging. During the aging process the wine lots were tasted throughout and blended back together just before bottling. The wine is aged 8-9 months in French Oak of which 20% is new.
