

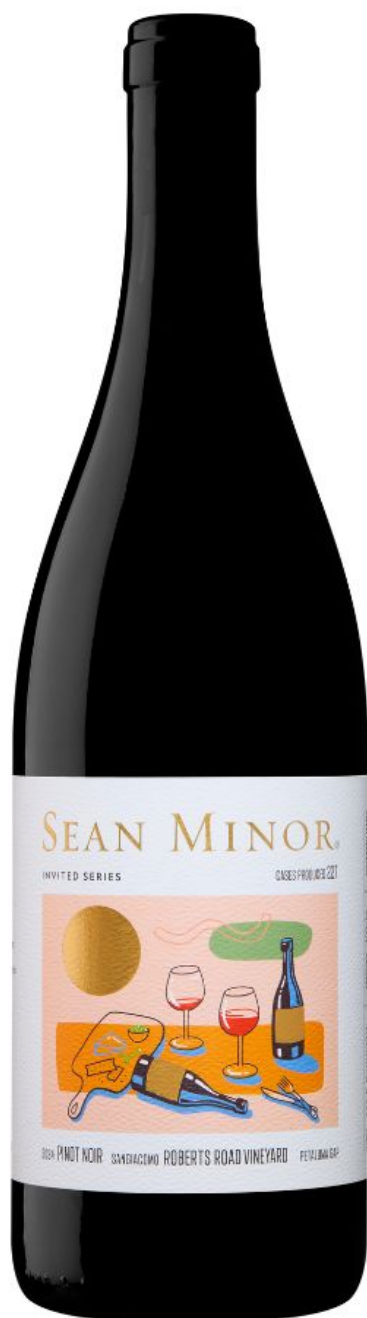

The Tasting Panel

A blend of clones 777 and Pommard planted in gravel with basalt, back in 1999. That vine age adds a few cool things: tension, grip, and dark-berry fruit with good concentration. Add to that nuances of wet slate and earth and saline minerality, all wrapped in a blanket of sweet oak and espresso-bean character. Aged 10 months in 30% new French oak. — Jonathan Cristaldi
